	<p>Gary SP Cheung (Hong Kong) Gary is the Associate Professor and Postgraduate Programme Director in Endodontics at the Faculty of Dentistry of the University of Hong Kong, and is an Honorary Professor to the stomatological schools of Wuhan University and of Sichuan University, both in China. He has an MSc in Conservative Dentistry (HK) and an MSc in Endodontics (Eastman Dental Institute, London). He is the founder of the Hong Kong Endodontic Society and he also serves as the Chairman of the Specialty Board in Endodontics in Hong Kong, and runs an intra-mural private practice on a referral basis. Dr. Cheung has published over 40 papers in peer-reviewed journals, and has lectured in Europe and US, as well as extensively in Asia.</p>
	<p>Fan Bin (China) Dr Fan is the Professor and Director of Endodontic Center in School & Hospital of Stomatology, Wuhan University. He is Assistant Editor of Journal of Oral Science Research and Chinese Journal of Dental research. He received his PhD in 1999 and was a Visiting Scholar at the ACTA, Netherlands. Dr Fan has authored more than 50 Endodontic articles published in national and international dental journals. His current subjects mainly lies in the research on C-shaped canal system and micro-endodontics.</p>
	<p>Bernard O Iskandar (Indonesia) Bernard is best known as the founder of The "Building Solid Foundation Endodontic Study Club". He has been a faculty member at the USAKTI since 1986. Never one to rest, Bernard also has a Certificate in Implantology from the Internationale Linkow Institute, Bremen, Germany, trained in Aesthetic and Implant Dentistry at the New York University and also undertaken Endodontic Microscopy training. Since 1995, he maintains a private practice limited to endodontics.</p>
	<p>Jeeraphat Jantararat (Thailand) Jeeraphat is a lecturer at the University of Mahidol. She received the University of Mahidol Dental Faculty's Young Lecturer Award in 2003. This amazing young lady received her MSc in Endodontics from the University of Melbourne in 1996 and pressed on to complete her PhD in 2000. She is an active member of the Endodontic Society of Thailand and balances her full time role as a lecturer with part-time private practice limited to endodontics.</p>
	<p>Ben Johnson (United States of America) Ben is perhaps best known as the inventor of the Thermafil Endodontic Obturator, the Profile 04 & 06 and the ProTaper Rotary NiTi Instruments. He is also well know as a contributor to endodontic causes and this was recognised with two honours from the American Association of Endodontists - the President's Award and the Philanthropist of the Year Award. He is well-travelled and is a familiar face at endodontic meetings around the world. He maintains a practice limited to endodontics and is also Clinical Professor at the Dental School of the Louisiana State University, New Orleans and the Baylor College of Dentistry, Dallas.</p>
	<p>Anil Kishen (Singapore) Anil Kishen has an MDS in Operative Dentistry & Endodontics from the Tamilnadu Medical University, Madras, India and a PhD in Biomedical Engineering from the Nanyang Technological University, Singapore. He is currently an Assistant Professor in the Department of Restorative Dentistry, National University of Singapore. He has more than 12 years of research experience in dentine biomaterials, biomechanics and photonics research. His other research interests are in dentine-microbial interactions, optical biochemical sensors and light activated disinfection. He has co-edited a book, published six invited book chapters, over eighty international publications in total, including over thirty research papers in peer refereed journals, and about eighteen invited lectures. He is co-inventor on two US patents, and recipient of many awards and honors, which includes research award from the Colgate-Palmolive, India and The Enterprise Challenge Innovator Award, Singapore. He serves as the editorial board member of the journal, Optics & Lasers in Engineering (OLE) and sectional editor of Singapore Dental Journal (SDJ).</p>

	<p>Harold Messer (Australia) Professor Harold Messer has recently retired from his position as Professor of Restorative Dentistry at the University of Melbourne after 16 years of teaching. He has been granted the title of emeritus professor, and continues to supervise seven PhD students, including five from Thailand). He has published approximately 160 papers in peer reviewed journals plus seven book chapters, and has trained approximately 60 postgraduate students in Endodontics, in his career at the University of Minnesota and the University of Melbourne. He is currently working on a chapter for the fourth edition of Walton and Torabinejad's textbook "Principles and Practice of Endodontics".</p>
	<p>Anish Vishnu Naware (India) Dr Naware has been practicing endodontic for the past twenty years in Mumbai. He founded the Integrated Endodontic Centre at Thane which treats endodontic cases and conducts continuing dental education programmes. He is also micro-endodontist at CAD, Breach Candy Hospital, Mumbai. To date, he has conducted more than 75 Hands-on Courses for 1000 dental surgeons all over India and been a keynote speaker in many national-level conferences. His lectures have been attended by over 10,000 dental surgeons from all over India. Recently in 2005, he lectured at the FDI-IDA Conference in Mumbai.</p>
